FAX, TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry form are not acceptable. **K9 ENTRY SERVICE WILL HELP WITH THIS YEAR THEIR NUMBER IS 1800-234-3043.**

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

ALL ENTRIES ARE TO BE MAILED WITH FEES TO: Debbie West, Show Secretary. 85 Old Church Hill Rd., Trumbull, CT 06611 Entries will not be accepted without fees. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practical. Should the exhibitor not receive such acknowledgement within a reasonable time, notify Debbie West, FAX 203-256-1359.

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES 5:00 PM, Wednesday, September 2, 2009, at the Show Secretary's home, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. The Club, the Show Entry Coordinator and Show Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This Club and its Show Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agent entering a dog twice or in a class for which the dog is ineligible to compete.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riot, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open the show, no refund of entry fee(s) will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, judges, exhibitors and spectators. The well being of dogs and participants is of paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

An AKC recording fee of \$.50 first entry only and a n AKC event fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial. An AKC recording fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in the Rally Trial These Recording Fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in a show or trial, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

DECLINATION OF ENTRIES – Quinnipiac Poodle Club, Inc. may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and none shall have any claim or recourse against Quinnipiac Poodle Club, Inc. or any official thereof.

THE SHOW WILL BE OPEN from 8:00AM to 5:00 PM. Consult the Judging Program for time of judging.

DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging. **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

ALL JUDGING WILL OCCUR at Paws 'N Effect.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a collection fee added to the amount of each returned check.

SPACE FOR UNENTERED DOGS will not be provided at this show.
